1. Suzanne Brown is 60 years old and has been referred to music therapy for pain. You approach her nurse to get information about the patient and the nurse expresses confusion about what you are there for. How might you explain your role as a music therapist in the hospital in 30 seconds or less?
2. How might you introduce music therapy services to a new patient who has been referred for mood elevation.
3. Using guitar, demonstrate your ability to play and sing one memorized song from the song choices below. Demonstrate this one song in the keys of C, D, E, G, and A.
 - a. Happy Birthday
 - b. Dreams by the Cranberries – first verse only
 - c. Give Me One Reason by Tracy Chapman – first verse only
 - d. Wildflowers by Tom Petty – first verse only
4. Using your piano, guitar, and vocal abilities, play one song that could be used in the medical setting for someone in their 30s and one song that could be used in the medical setting for someone in their 70s.
